

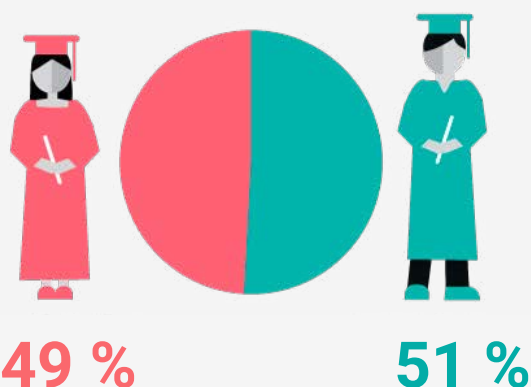

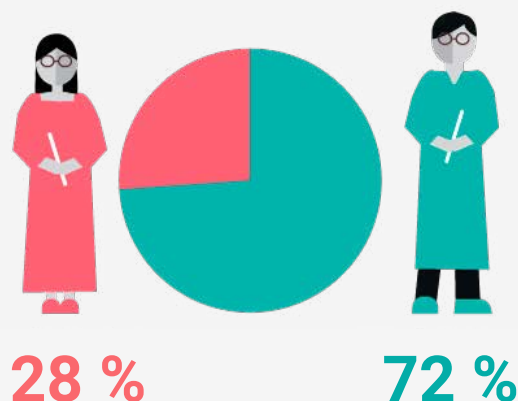
Share of women in professor positions

Women and men who have completed a doctorate in the Nordics:



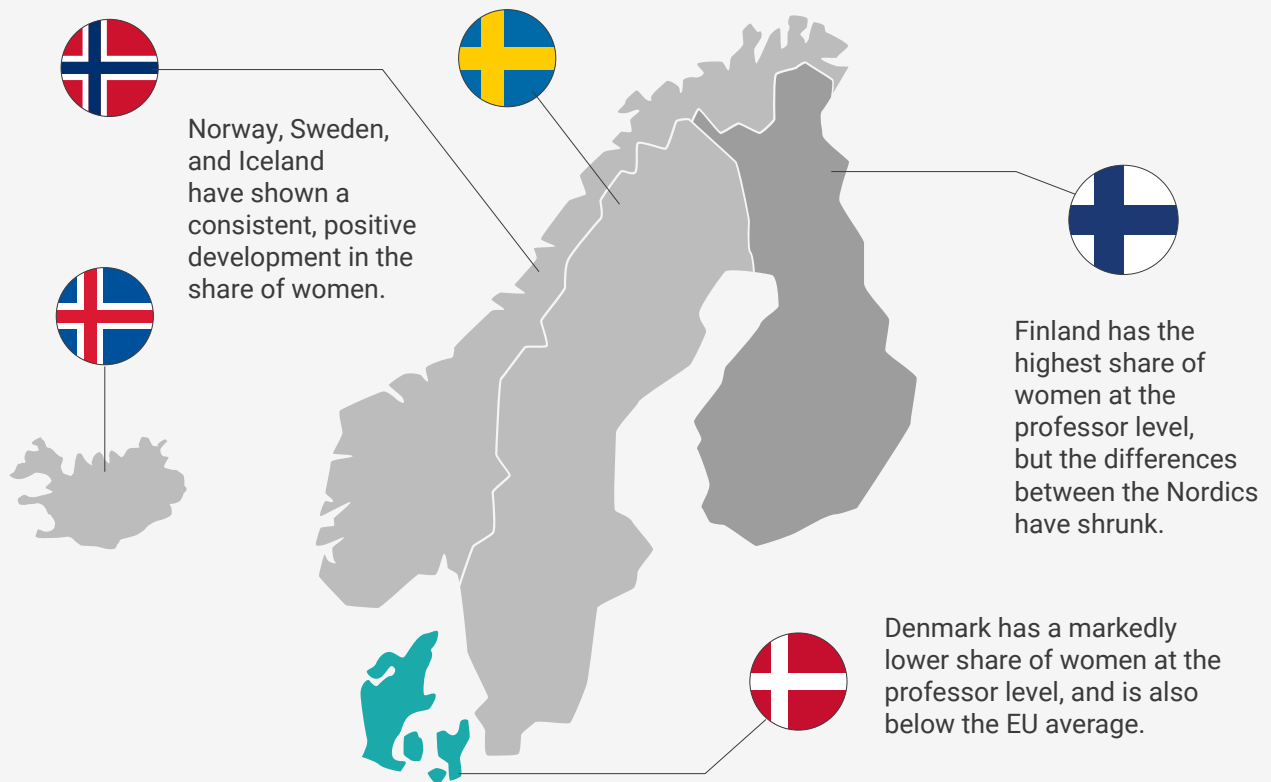
Women and men with full professor positions in the Nordics:



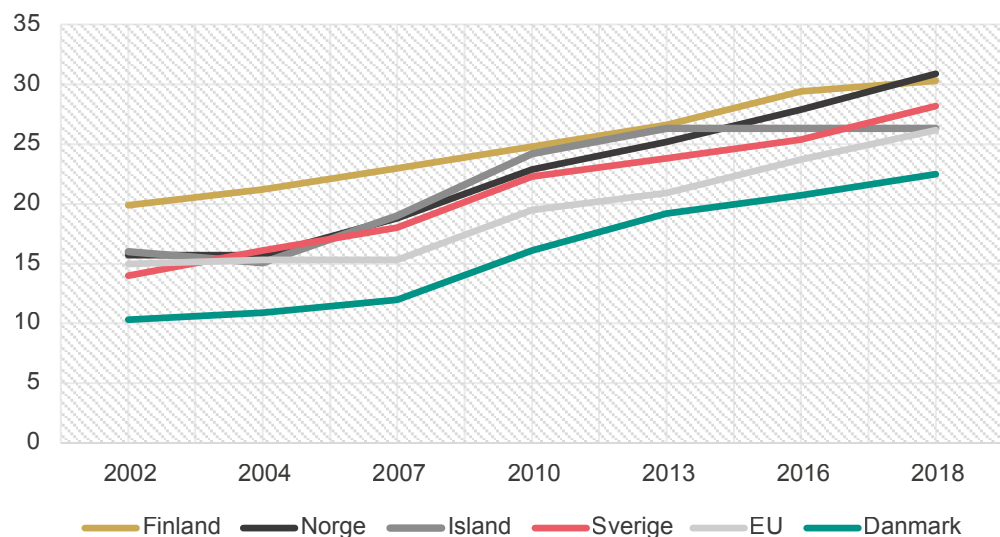
- Approximately the same amount of women and men complete PhDs. This has been the case for the past ten years.

The share of female professors is steadily increasing across the Nordic region

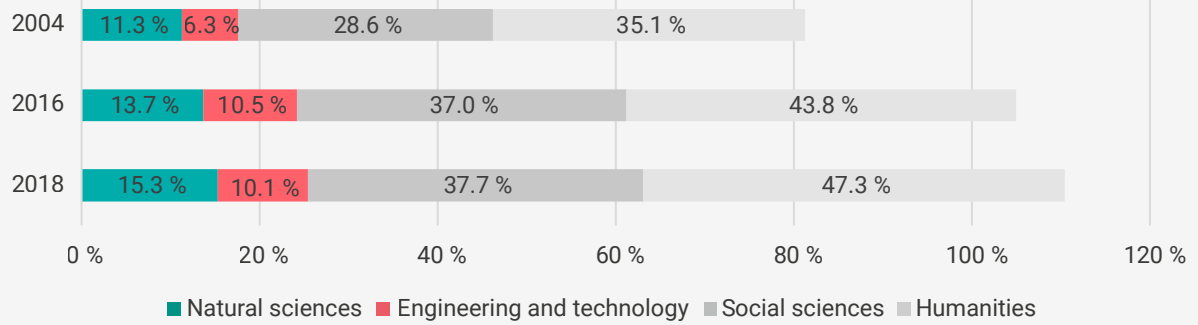


Share of female professors in the Nordics

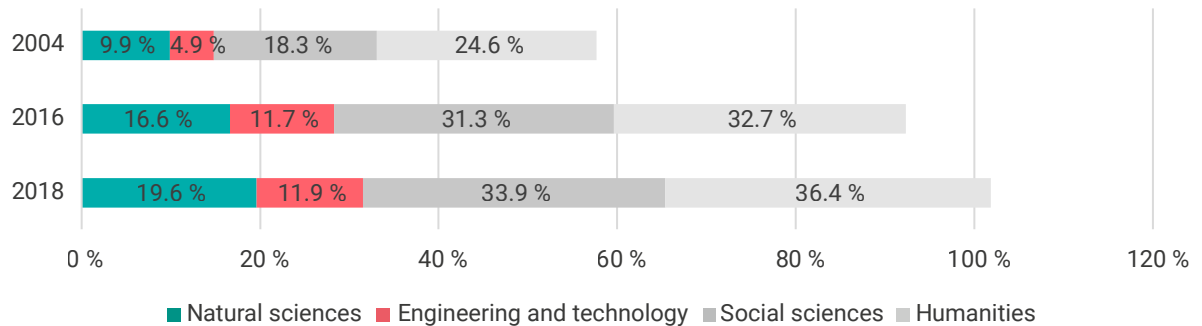


Norway and Sweden are the best on STEM subjects among the Nordics

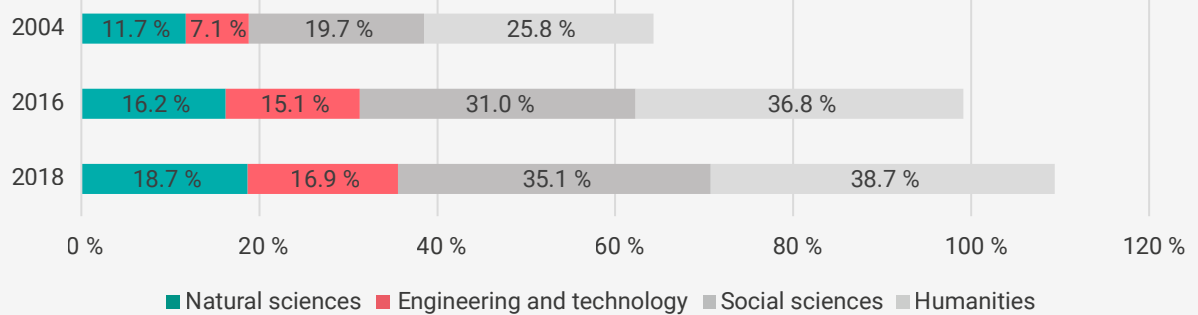

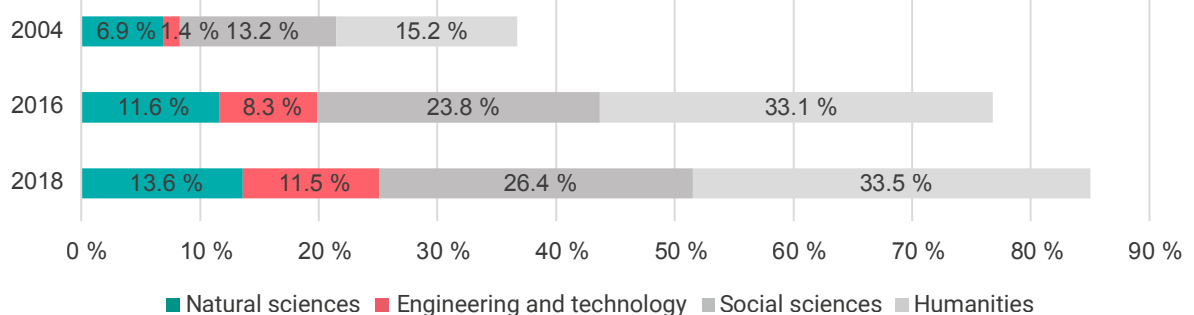
